
Holy Mount Kailash & Sacred Lake Mansarovar June 2020

HELICOPTER ROUTE Via SIMIKOT - HILSA:

Kailash Mansarovar Yatra by Helicopter is a suitable program for those Yatries who are willing to complete this Yatra with ease, however possible. This holy journey starts from Lucknow to Nepalganj and Nepalgunj to Simikot by scheduled flight and from Simikot to Hilsa by chartered Helicopter Service. From Hilsa (Nepal China border), the pilgrims picked up by deluxe coach and transferred to the Border Town of Tibet Taklakot/Purang, from there they proceed towards the exotic Yatra of Kailash and Mansarovar.

Itinerary (10 Days)

Day 01 – 8th June 2020: Lucknow to Nepalgunj (168m): Pick up from Lucknow; Train/Airport/Hotel and drive 5 hours to Nepalgunj. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 02 – 9th June 2020: Nepalgunj to Simikot (2910m)-Hilsa (3700m): Early morning, transfer to Nepalgunj Airport. Fly 50 minutes to Simikot, further fly 20 minutes by Helicopter to Hilsa. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 03 – 10th June 2020: Hilsa to Purang (3800m): Trek shortly, cross Karnali River to Sher. Enter Tibet and drive an hour to Taklakot (Purang). Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 04 - 11th June 2020: Purang: The day is free for acclimatization and Purang Excursion.

Day 05 – 12th June 2020: Purang to Mansarovar (4560m): One and half hour drive to Chiu Gompa. Start Mansarovar Parikrama by ECO Coach. Holy Bath & Pooja during Parikrama. Overnight stay at Ashram.

Day 06 – 13th June 2020: Mansarovar to Darchen (4580m): Early Morning Pooja at Mansarovar and drive one hour to Darchen. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 07 - 14th June 2020: Darchen to Driaphuk (4890m) - 6 to 7 hours

Early morning drive about 20 minutes to Yam Dwar. Start Kailash Parikrama on Foot to Driaphuk. Overnight stay at Guest House.

Day 08 - 15th June 2020: Driaphuk to Zuthulphuk (4790m) - 8 to 9 hours.

Start trek as early as possible, cross Dolma-La (5670m). Darshan of Ganesh Kund and Gauri Kund. Overnight stay at Guest House.

Day 09 – 16th June 2020: Zuthulphuk to Simikot Via Hilsa.

Trek about 3 hours ending Kailash Parikrama at Mani Wall. Drive about 4 hours to Sher, embark Tibet-China and Enter to Hilsa- Nepal. Further; Heli -Lift to Simikot. Overnight stay at Guest House.

Day 10 – 17th June 2020: Simikot / Nepalgunj to Lucknow.

Early in the morning fly to Nepalgunj and further drive to Lucknow. THE JOURNEY – ENDS

COST INCLUDES:

- Accommodation at Nepalguni with all meals.
- Scheduled flight; Nepalgunj Simikot Nepalgunj.
- Chartered helicopter flight; Simikot Hilsa Simikot.

Important notes:

- > The scan copy of passport; front page (photo page), last page (address page) and colour scan of MRP format Photo must be sent prior to 30 days of Yatra.
- > The passport of Pilgrims will be hand over at Nepalgunj (Heli-Route) and at Kathmandu (Overland Route). We advise all pilgrims to carry Election Card as optional traveling document to fly Kathmandu.

Risk and Liabilities:

We assure to make your journey as smooth and pleasant as possible. However, the entire program in Tibet is operated strictly under the rules and regulations of Tibet Tourism Bureau of China. Therefore, *Green Earth Adventures* & its associate partners will not be responsible for any changes in the itineraries due to unavoidable circumstances such as Government restrictions, landslides, road blockages, flood, snow, and any unforeseen types of obstructions, cancellation / delay of flight, delay due to late permit and Visa, illness or accidents. The pilgrims must bear all the extra costs incurred due to above mentioned circumstances that arise during the Yatra.

> Passport with a minimum of 6 months' validity

Fitness:

This is not a trek or expedition but a tour; therefore, no specific level of fitness is required. Anyone can join this Yatra who are physically normal with strong willpower.
